- Concert Raffle/Parent's Night Out netted \$160 more than anticipated
- Margarita's Benefit Night raised \$260
- Kids Artwork, expense was around \$1,300, netted \$700 for project
- NFS Gear ordered, outstanding orders to be filled soon
- Funded \$3,000 towards field trips, for The Music Hall, Applecrest, Emery Farm
- Modest amounts spent on Teacher Grants (\$100), Garden (\$70), and Health Try-it Program (\$30)
