



1. **Where will the playground will be built?** It will be built in the back of the school between the school and the ball field as close to the school as possible.
2. **What structures are identified?** The process for selecting the structures and layout began during the 2012/2013 school year with a few dedicated volunteers working to solicit recommendations from the playground company. In the fall of 2013, a request for volunteers went out and the Playground Committee came together. The process for selecting the final structures and layout will include student, staff, and parent input. Two final designs will be put to the NFS community for a vote. Suggestions for structures and layout should be directed to nfspto03801@gmail.com or a Playground Committee Member. Ultimately, the size and scope will be determined by our fundraising effort and the final product will be a wonderful addition to the overall NFS experience.
3. **What is the timeline for implementation (is this for use next school year)?** We are optimistic that we will complete the fundraising campaign by June 1 of 2014 and begin construction in August. We will keep the community up to date on our progress.
4. **What will the money fund - how much of the money will go to equipment and labor for the investment vs. brochure/misc. admin costs to promote this fundraiser?** We anticipate that the fundraising campaign costs will be less than \$500.
5. **Will donors to the Playground Fund be recognized?** Donors may choose to be recognized or remain anonymous. Recognition may include print and/or electronic acknowledgments, listing on onsite donor plaque, and other means yet to be determined.
6. **What is the plan if you don't get to the full amount? Will a smaller project be implemented?** This project has been wanted and needed for generations of NFS kids and parents, and we are very confident that we will be able to achieve our goals. We have deliberately chosen not to entertain the idea of a partial implementation so that we remain 100% focused on the goal. We believe a full implementation is attainable. In the unlikely event our fundraising goal is not met, we may "value engineer" the project budget to meet our resources.
